Does Angola have a solar energy project?

An agreement for the provision of \$900 million in funding to support the implementation of the Angola Solar Energy Project was reached between Angola's Ministry of Energy and Water and the U.S. Export-Import Bank in June 2023.

Who owns a power station in Angola?

The power station is in the development stage, by a consortium comprising Total Eren, a subsidiary of TotalEnergies, the French oil conglomerate, in collaboration with Greentech-Angola Environment Technology and Sonangol, the Angolan energy parastatal.

How can Angola increase its power generation capacity?

Angola is working hard to increase its power generation capacity by boosting hydro and solar energy, as well as linking and expanding its electric grids. This will create more sustainable income sources, promote the global energy transition, increase the country's exports and modernise the economic possibilities of its citizens.

How many solar projects are eligible for grid connection in Angola?

Among these, 3,436 MW (120 projects) are eligible for grid connection in the short term until 2017. Among the provinces of Angola, Luanda, Cuanza Norte and Cuanza Sul are the ones with the highest viability for projects due to the strong capacity of the grid to absorb intermittent power. How will Angola's new solar power plant affect the environment?



The solar facility will mitigate the emissions of 224,000 tons of carbon dioxide while providing employment to 600 people. Developed in phases, the facility will be operational for 20 years and falls in line with efforts by Angola to generate 500 MW of renewable energy capacity by 2025.
