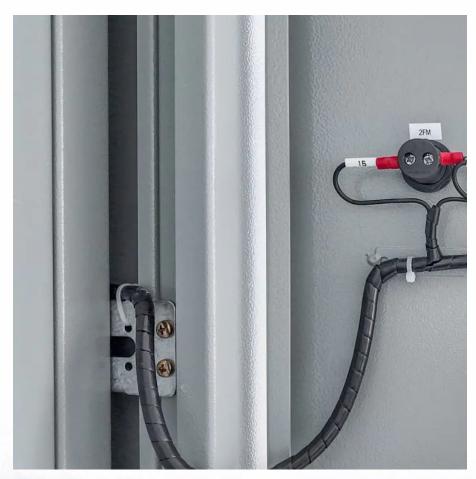


# **Angola Tour Outdoor Power Supply**







#### **Overview**

Do I need a power plug adapter in Angola?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug. Commonly used in Europe, South-America and Asia, but also in quite a few other countries. Plugs of type E and F will also fit in a type C outlet. Angola only has one type of power plug; the ungrounded European style type C (Europlug).

Do I need a travel adapter in Angola?

If you are traveling to Angola with electronic devices that use different plug types, you will need to bring a travel adapter. It is important to ensure that the adapter you purchase is compatible with both the plug type used in Angola and the plug type used by your device. You can find travel adapters at most electronics stores or online.

Are there electrical outlets in Angola?

No, the electrical outlets in Angola are different from those in the United States. In Angola electrical outlets of type C are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Angola?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Angola are of type C (see images).

What type of plug does Angola use?

Angola uses a standard voltage of 220 volts and a frequency of 50 Hz. The country uses plug type C, which has two round pins. This plug type is commonly found in Europe and many other parts of the world. If you are traveling to Angola with electronic devices that use different plug types, you will need to bring a travel adapter.

Which plugs fit in a Type C outlet in Angola?

Plugs of type E and F will also fit in a type C outlet. Angola only has one type



of power plug; the ungrounded European style type C (Europlug). If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Angola, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter.

What voltage does Angola use?

Also, the voltage in Angola is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Angola Use?

Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps.
