Does Barbados have a reliable electricity supply network?

While power outages and voltage fluctuations still occur, Barbados now has one of the region's most reliable and sustainable electricity supply networks. Currently, the Barbados Light & Power Company (BLPC) is responsible for providing electricity to the island, and most of its power comes from imported fossil fuels.

Does Barbados have a power supply?

The standard power supply in Barbados has 110 volt / 50 Hz and 2-pin sockets (system and sockets are the same as in the U.S.A.). Some individuals and hotels also have additional power supply and outlets for the 220-240 volts System. If you are not from the United States of America you will probably need a socket adapter for U.S. outlets.

Barbados, a small Caribbean island nation located in the easternmost part of the Lesser Antilles, has made great strides in improving its electricity supply network in recent years. The country has significantly reduced its reliance on imported fossil fuels and increased its renewable energy capacity.

Electricity in Barbados is 110 volts/50 cycles. There is a reliable electricity supply, with only the occasional outage. Standard plug types in Barbados are: If traveling from North America you should be able to use your appliances without any problems, however if travelling from UK & Europe you may need adapters and transformers.
