Does EIB support Engie's deployment of solar home systems in Benin?

EIB backs Engie's deployment of solar home systems in Benin The European Investment Bank (EIB) has agreed a €10m (\$10.2m) local currency loan backing the deployment of 107,000 solar home systems in Benin by Engie Energy Access. The systems are expected to provide power to around 643,000 people.

Can solar power power rural communities far from the grid in Benin?

As solar energy is abundant across the country, this model can be suitable to power rural communities far from the grid in Benin. Compared to currently deployed PV/battery systems, the present study, recommends the off-grid hybrid PV/DG/battery system for future electrification projects in Benin.

How many households in Benin use off-grid solar?

Only 10% of households are currently using off-grid solar products. "More than one million households don't have access to modern and sustainable energy in Benin alone," says Hendrik Engelmann-Pilger, a senior economist in the European Investment Bank's energy transition programmes division.

Will Benin be able to access electricity?

"For the first time, more than half a million people across Benin will be able to access electricity that will power communications, provide light and make cooking easier.

Who is Engie energy access Benin?

The European Investment Bank signed a loan of €10 million to ENGIE Energy Access Benin, a subsidiary of ENGIE, to support the deployment of 107 000 high-quality solar home systems in Benin. This will open up access to clean energy for an estimated 643 000 people in the West African country.



Can a hybrid PV/DG/battery system power remote areas in Benin?

In summary, as solar radiation is an abundant resource across the country, this hybrid PV/DG/battery system can be a suitable model to power remote areas in Benin, and we recommend it for future electrification projects in the country in place of the current widely deployed PV/battery system. 1.
