

Can I bring a portable power bank to Southeast Asia







Overview

Can you use a power bank on a plane?

Airlines said passengers can bring and use their power banks inside the aircraft, but old and worn-out power banks are not allowed. Power banks with a capacity of 100Wh or less are allowed on board. This is equivalent to 20,000mAh to 27,000 mAh depending on the output voltage, according to Cebu Pacific.

Is a power bank allowed in a carry-on?

Yes, it's allowed in your carry-on as it falls below the 100 Wh limit. Similarly, if you have a 20,000 mAh protable charger, it would be approximately 74 Wh. This is also within the allowed range for carry-on luggage. Watt-hours = $(20,000 \text{ mAh} \times 3.7 \text{ V}) / 1000 = 74 \text{ Wh Now, let's consider a 50,000 mAh}$ power bank:

Can you put a power bank in a bag?

Avoid using a power bank inside a bag as it can overheat. Power banks are treated the same way by most airlines because the rules come from safety bodies like IATA (International Air Transport Association) and the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration). The good news is that the important points are pretty straightforward.

How many power banks can you take on a plane?

Know the Limits: Most airlines allow up to two power banks per passenger, but



some (like Delta) permit up to 20 spare batteries. Confirm with your airline to avoid surprises. Be Airport-Smart: In China and some EU countries, unmarked power banks or those without clear capacity labels may be confiscated.

How many power banks can I use without approval?

Up to twenty power banks under 100 Wh allowed without approval. Two units 100 to 160 Wh require airline approval. Over 160 Wh not accepted. No inflight use limits listed. Under 100 Wh allowed without approval. Two units 101 to 160 Wh require airline approval. Over 160 Wh prohibited. No in-flight use limits listed.
