Can you bring a power bank on a plane?

Always pack your power bank in your carry-on —they're not allowed in checked luggage. Batteries under 100 watt-hours (Wh) are automatically allowed. This covers most standard phone and tablet power banks. If your charger is between 100 and 160 Wh, you can bring up to two—but you'll need approval from the airline before you board.

Can you put a power bank in a bag?

Avoid using a power bank inside a bag as it can overheat. Power banks are treated the same way by most airlines because the rules come from safety bodies like IATA (International Air Transport Association) and the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration). The good news is that the important points are pretty straightforward.

Are power banks allowed in checked baggage?

Power banks are not allowed in checked baggage under any circumstances. Capacity Restrictions: ≤ 100 Wh (Watt-hours): Permitted without prior airline approval. 100Wh to 160Wh: Permitted with airline approval, typically limited to two units per passenger. > 160Wh: Not allowed on passenger aircraft.

What is a power bank on a plane?

Skip down to the airline rules and tips for safe travels if you already know your power bank terminology, or read on for a quick recap on power bank basics. At its simplest, a power bank is a rechargeable battery, usually lithium-ion, inside a protective case with electronics that manage safe charging.

Are power banks safe?

Power banks are treated the same way by most airlines because the rules come from safety bodies like IATA (International Air Transport Association) and the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration). The good news is that the



important points are pretty straightforward. You must keep power banks in your carry-on cabin bag.

What should you not do with a power bank?

Avoid exposing your power bank to extreme heat or cold (like leaving it in a car), as this can shorten its lifespan or damage it. Don't buy a dodgy or unknown brand power bank. Don't use a power bank that's cracked or starting to swell. Avoid using a power bank inside a bag as it can overheat.
