Do I need permission to install a solar panel?



Generally, any solar panel installation under 1MW is permitted without any additional approval required. Similarly to domestic installations, for no permission to be requested, there are several regulations to be met for commercial solar panel installations.

Can I install solar panels on my property?

If your property is situated in a conservation area, it may be possible to install solar panels under Permitted Rights. However, if you're planning to install the panels in a way that would be visible from a highway, a planning application and consent from the local authority will be necessary.
