Overview

What are the import & export restrictions in East Timor?

Get import & export customs regulations, restricted items and food restrictions before travelling to East Timor. Items allowed to import is Goods intended for personal use, such as clothing and toiletries. Prohibited items is Live ornamental plants for individuals.

What does the customs authority do in Timor-Leste?

The Customs Authority helps the Government of Timor-Leste to control the movement of goods, vehicles, ships, and aircraft that enter and leave the country. As well as protecting our borders from the import or export of illegal or restricted goods, we also help to collect duties and taxes which is an important source of national revenue.

What are the import and export laws in Timor-Leste?

In Timor-Leste, various categories of goods are either prohibited or restricted from import and export activities. Understanding the regulations surrounding these goods is vital for traders to avoid legal issues and ensure compliance with national laws.

How do imports work in Timor-Leste?

Imports: When commercial goods enter Timor-Leste, they do so by air or by sea, or via a land border. When the goods arrive, they are initially considered to be in "temporary storage." After arrival, there is a legal requirement for the goods to be placed under a "customs treatment" within a specified time frame.

Do Timor-Leste exporters need a permit?

Exporters in Timor-Leste face similar compliance obligations. They are required to obtain various permits to legally export goods, which may include documentation that validates the nature and origin of the products.



What is Timor-Leste's customs system?

Timor-Leste has established a structured customs procedure that importers and exporters must diligently follow to facilitate the movement of goods across its borders. The process is designed to ensure that trade complies with national regulations and contributes to the economic stability of the nation.
