Is the Las Palmas power plant a bunker power plant?

Recent reports from Guatemala's Ministry of Energy and Mines, including the power generation planning report for 2020-2034 and the energy expansion plan for 2022-2052, have shown the Las Palmas power plant to have a single 67 MW unit fueled entirely by bunker rather than coal.

Where is Las Palmas power station?

Las Palmas power station (Planta Eléctrica Las Palmas 2) is an operating power station of at least 66-megawatts (MW) in Escuintla City, Escuintla, Guatemala with multiple units, some of which are not currently operating.
