How many mobile base stations are there in the UK?

The number of mobile base stations providing 5G services has more than doubled over the last year to over 6,500 sites across the UK – 87 percent of these are in England, 8 percent in Scotland, 3 percent in Wales and 2 percent Northern Ireland.

Where is 5G available in the UK?

2. 5G is now available in over 100 UK towns and cities, including London, Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast. While 5G deployment today is primarily focused on providing additional network capacity in densely populated areas, in the longer term 5G will play a central role in the smart and connected cities and towns of the future.

What is a 5G base station?

They help fill coverage gaps, improve network reliability, and handle high data traffic. In cities, more than 60% of 5G base stations are small cells, placed on rooftops, lampposts, and building facades. These mini base stations are crucial for delivering consistent 5G speeds in crowded areas like stadiums, shopping malls, and business districts.

How fast is 5G in the UK?

At the latest count 128 towns and cities across UK currently have access to 5G through the Vodafone network, with other G levels covering 99% of the population. In October 2020, Vodafone was found to have a 22.4/8.5 Mbps download and upload speed with a 39.0ms latency making the network second place.

How many 5G base stations are there in the United States?

While China leads in sheer numbers, the U.S. is making steady progress. By late 2023, the country had between 150,000 and 200,000 active 5G base



stations. The deployment strategy in the U.S. is different from China's, as it relies on private investment rather than government-led initiatives. Is this article too long?
