Do Europeans need a travel adapter in Georgia?

Europeans do not need a travel adapter or transformer when traveling to Georgia. Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Georgia. Also, the voltage in Georgia is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Georgia Use?

Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin.

Do North Americans need a transformer if traveling to Georgia?

No! North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Georgia. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Georgia. Also, the voltage in Georgia is different from North American voltages.

Do I need a power plug adapter in Georgia?

You need a power plug adapter in Georgia, when living in the United States of America. You also need a voltage converter. Be extra careful with certain appliances because of the difference in frequency. Below you find pictures of the applied power sockets and corresponding plugs. And we provide more information about the voltage and frequency.

What voltage does Georgia use?



Also, the voltage in Georgia is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Georgia Use?

Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps.

What type of plug do I need in Georgia?

In Georgia the power plug sockets are of type C and F. The standard voltage is 220 V and the frequency is 50 Hz. Power plug adapter needed in Georgia?
