

#### **Overview**

Does Nord Pool offer normalized price indices for a set resolution?

For users who require different resolutions, Nord Pool has introduced normalized price indices for a set resolution. The change only applies to delivery dates after go-live date.

Do I need a license to use Nord Pool data?

Any redistribution, inclusive of redistributing derived data from Nord Pool data, requires a separate license. Data used for trading and/or trade settlement purposes on financial markets also requires a separate license. Special terms apply to trading members, students, researchers, and members of academic entities. ✓ Day-Ahead Market.

What is a negative price in the Nordics?

Negative prices in the Nordics driven by Nordic price areas are often in the range of -6 to 0 EUR/MWh, with the stable lower boundary coming from the price level of the GoO, which allow Nordic producers to bid negative down to the current GoO price (e.g. 6 EUR/MWh) into the spot market without taking a loss.
