Overview

The \$20 million BESS project will stabilise Malawi's hydropower-reliant grid, enhance electricity access, and reduce carbon emissions by 10,000 tonnes annually. This initiative is part of GEAPP's BESS Consortium, which aims to deploy 5 GW of storage in low-middle-income countries by 2024.
