

Overview

Who supervises Telecommunications in the Maldives?

As of April 2019, telecommunications in the Maldives are under the control and supervision of the Communications Authority of Maldives (CAM). There are three telecommunications operators in the Maldives: Dhiraagu, Ooredoo Maldives, and Raajjé Online. Mobile network operators: 2, Dhiraagu and Ooredoo Maldives.

What are the mobile network operators in Maldives?

There are two mobile network operators in Maldives: Dhiraagu and Ooredoo Maldives (as of 2020). The telephone system includes domestic communication through microwave links, with all inhabited islands connected to telephone and fax service. For international communication, there is a satellite earth station using three Intelsat satellites in the Indian Ocean.

What is the telephone system in the Maldives?

The telephone system in the Maldives includes domestic communication through microwave links, with all inhabited islands connected to telephone and fax service. For international communication, there is a satellite earth station serving 3 Intelsat (Indian Ocean) and three Internet Service Providers: Dhiraagu, Ooredoo Maldives, and Raajjé Online (as of 2020).
