Overview

Does Mozambique have a telecommunication sector?

In May 2018, the World Bank approved \$150m IDA grant for Government of Mozambique's Integrated Feeder Road Development Project. Growth has been strong in recent years, as the telecoms sector grew by 11% in 20169. Mozambique's Communications Regulatory Authority (INCM) regulates telecommunications.

Does Mozambique have a 5G network?

Dimension Data Mozambique extends its satellite service to Mozambique using OneWeb's constellation of 648 LEO satellites. Vodacom Mozambique launches the first commercial 5G services in the country. Mozambique Telecom progresses with the second phase of its network modernisation program.

Which mobile phone company operates in Mozambique?

Although Vodacom is the dominant mobile phone operator in Mozambique with almost 50% market share, Tmcel is the only entity that continues to offer integrated fixed line service. According to World Bank, Mozambique registered approximately 16 million mobile subscriptions in 2020 which corresponds to more than half of the population.

Will Mozambique auction 4G spectrum?

Mozambique's National Communications Institute (INCM) has opened applications for its auction of 4G wireless spectrum. In Oct 2018, if all frequencies are sold the auction will raise at least \$390m. Mozambique is one of Africa's most climate-vulnerable countries.

Does Mozambique have a data center?

Amazon Web Services (AWS), Heroku, and Microsoft Azure are among the many international companies that offer cloud services to Mozambique, but do



not operate their own in-country data centers. However, U.S. investment firm Roha, which aims to build and operate a world-class tier 3 data center in partnership with high-tech group Raxio.

Why is Mozambique launching a telecom reform?

Mozambique was one of the first countries in the region to embark upon telecom reform and to open the sector to competition. The mobile segment in particular has shown strong growth since the launch of services by Vodacom Mozambique to compete against mCel, the then mobile subsidiary of the national telco Telecomunicações de Moçambique.
