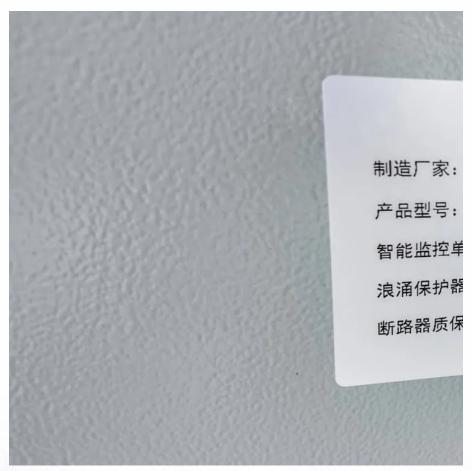


North African energy storage project benefits
