Overview

Can green cities be replicable in Rwanda?

According to the Chief Executive Officer of Rwanda Green Fund, Herbert Ruzibiza, the project will demonstrate the viability of green cities in Rwanda, and relevant for replicability for the development of Green Secondary Cities at the national level.

What is the Rwanda Green Fund?

This innovative project "will integrate green building and design, efficient and renewable energy, recycling and inclusive living, homegrown solutions and local construction materials", the CEO notes. The Rwanda Green Fund, FONERWA, has been supported by the German Cooperation through KfW to implement this project.

Where is the tallest building in Rwanda?

Location: Central Business District, Kigali. Details: This 29-story mixed-use development is set to become the tallest building in Rwanda. It will feature office spaces, retail areas, and parking facilities, and is designed to be the first Gold Rated LEED Green, Well, and Smart Mix-Use Complex in the country.

What is a 'green affordable house' project in Rwanda?

The phase two of the project will be setting up "Green affordable houses under the contact with Rwanda Social Security Board (RSSB) on 125 ha. This will be followed by construction of commercial and office buildings attracting Innovative Green Businesses.

How much does a mega project cost in Rwanda?

Here are ten notable mega projects: Duration: Construction began in April 2021, with completion expected by December 2025. Cost: Approximately US\$214 million. Partners: Rwanda Energy Group and Sinohydro (main contractor). Location: Shyorongi, Rulindo District, Northern Province.



How many houses will be built in Rwanda?

The project is expected to surface the construction of 410 houses that will be built by a local contractor; Horizon Construction Ltd on 13 ha. The phase two of the project will be setting up "Green affordable houses under the contact with Rwanda Social Security Board (RSSB) on 125 ha.
