Overview

Can solar power be used in Rwanda?

Rwanda has chosen to focus on the use of solar power in two main areas: electrification of clinics, schools and administrative offices in remote centers and solar water heating. This approach offers significant environmental and recurrent cost savings, substituting biomass and electricity water heating.

What is the energy policy of Rwanda?

Rwanda's energy policy includes expanding the usage of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG). According to the country's energy-use statistics, 85% of households depend on biomass energy, with fuelwood dominating the cooking energy mix. The current adoption rate of LPG is still low.

Will Rwanda have 100% electricity by 2024?

The Chairman of EPD Dr Ivan Twagirashema said that EPD is committed to play a significant role to the Rwanda's target of having 100% electricity access by 2024, where 52% will be on-grid and off-grid 48%. He said that "hydropower provides around a fifth of current capacity but not even a tenth of its total potential is being utilized".
