

## Solar panel cleaning







## **Overview**

Learn when and how to clean your solar panels, and why most of the time they don't need it. Find out the best tools, tips and techniques to keep your panels efficient and safe.

Some exceptions might be if you notice excessive bird droppings, after heavy dust storms in places like Arizona or when you live directly next to or downwind from major highways, factories or agricultural fields. In these instances, it's possible to generate enough.

Early morning or in the evening (ideally on an overcast day) is best. Too much sun on wet panels can cause them to dry too quickly and smudge.

Generally, cleaning your solar panels isn't something you need to bother with. The best way to figure out if your panels need cleaning is to assess the above conditions. For the most part.

1. Be sure to check your panel manufacturer instructions for shutting down the system before cleaning, if necessary. Try not to go on the roof to clean your system. It's risky both for you and your panels. 2. Brushing any loose dirt off before spraying.

What is solar panel cleaning?

Solar panel cleaning is the most common maintenance performed on residential phototactic (PV) energy systems, especially those in dry or windy areas. When dirt, dust, debris, or animal droppings accumulate on the surface of your solar panels, blocked sunlight can significantly reduce their energy production.

What is the best solar panel cleaner?

Water is the best solar panel cleaner, especially if it's deionized or distilled. This water attracts other chemicals, so it's more efficient for cleaning. If deionized or distilled water isn't available, treating hose water with a water softener can help improve its cleaning power.
