

Storage Cabinet Installation







Overview

How do you install cabinets in a garage?

The initial step is to prepare the garage space for cabinet installation. Clear the area of any clutter and ensure all the garage surfaces including the walls are clean. Inspect the walls and floor for any damage that may require repair. When installing wall-mounted cabinets, securely attaching them to studs is crucial.

How do you install a cabinet?

To install a cabinet, drive at least two screws at the top and two at the bottom. For narrow cabinets that don't span two studs, use toggle bolts. When screwing a cabinet into place, hold a level upright against the front. You may need to loosen screws and insert shims behind the top or bottom to make the cabinet plumb.

What Is the Safest Method to Hang a Garage Cabinet?

The most effective way to hang a garage cabinet securely is by using robust screws or bolts to fasten the cabinet directly to wall studs. This method ensures optimal stability and weight-bearing capacity, guaranteeing that the cabinet remains firmly attached to the wall.

How do I install wall-mounted cabinets?

Prioritize the installation of wall-mounted cabinets. Determine the most



suitable height for installation, taking into consideration factors such as your personal height and accessibility requirements. Once the height has been determined, securely attach the cabinets to the designated stud positions. The next step is to install the base cabinets.

How do you install open shelves on a cabinet?

To install open shelves on a cabinet, drill the shelf support holes ahead of securing the cabinets to the wall. Use a scrap of pegboard and a drill bit with a stop to position these holes. After drilling, remove the cabinet doors to make installation easier.
