Overview

How is energy used in Suriname?

Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country.

What products are exported to Suriname?

Principal U.S. exports to Suriname include chemicals, excavating machinery and other machine parts, and food, including meat and poultry. U.S. consumer products are widely available through Suriname's privately held trading and import-export companies.

What is the agricultural industry in Suriname?

The agricultural industry plays a major part in Suriname's economy which is illustrated by the fact that approximately twenty five per cent of wokers in the country are employed in this sector. Bananas and rice are two particularly important crops in Suriname.

How much money does Suriname import?

Imports in Suriname averaged 382.71 USD Million from 2006 until 2025, reaching an all time high of 594.10 USD Million in the third quarter of 2013 and a record low of 220.60 USD Million in the first quarter of 2006. source: Central Bank of Suriname Suriname's main imports are food, fuel, clothing and machinery.
