What are Bosnia & Herzegovina tariffs?

Tariffs refer to the taxes levied by BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA on goods entering or leaving its borders in accordance with local laws. Regardless of the declared purpose of the items you send, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA customs can determine the import duties to be levied on those items based on factors such as their value and quantity.

Tariffs plus value-added tax equals import tax.

Which goods are taxed in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

Goods imported into Bosnia and Herzegovina and placed in free circulation are subject to payment of value added tax (VAT) at the rate of 17 percent while certain groups of products (e.g. coffee, cigarettes, oil, oil derivatives etc.) are subject to payment of specific taxes (excise) in accordance with the Law on Excise of BiH.

What is the cost to fly to Bosnia and Herzegovina?

Currently, there are no airlines that fly direct to Bosnia and Herzegovina, but we found flights with one or more stops from ₹ 47,648. The cheapest month to fly to Bosnia and Herzegovina is currently August 2022, as we found the cheapest fares for this month.



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
