What are the dimensions of a shipping container?

Their predictable dimensions also ensure that cargo-loaded containers can be safely transported by road, sea, or rail—powering global trade as we know it today. Standard ISO shipping containers are 20-foot or 40-foot long, with a standard width of 8 feet.

Why are standard containers called ISO containers?

The standard containers are also called ISO containers due to the flexible and multimodal applications provided by the International Organization for Standardization. Find dimensions, sizes and specifications for all shipping container types. Find out which type of container is best suited for your shipment.

What is a standard shipping container?

Shipping containers are held to very specific dimensional standards to ensure they can be safely stacked on top of, and below, any other shipping container in the world. Standard shipping containers are 8' wide (2.44m), and are measured in TEU's (twenty-foot equivalent units).

Why is a standard container size important?

A consistent standard container dimension ensures that containers can transition between different forms of transport without any problem. Also, by adhering to the standard size of the ISO container, businesses optimize how they pack goods, leaving no space wasted.

What are the ISO container specifications?

How big is a 10ft shipping container?

The internal volume of a 10ft shipping container is 561 ft³. Five feet longer than their more common 40ft counterparts, 45ft shipping containers can be used for the same purposes and are ideal for those looking for a little more space and loading capacity.
