What is the best travel adapter for Samoa in 2025?

In Samoa, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type I are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Samoa is a beautiful island nation in the South Pacific, known for its stunning beaches, lush rainforests, and vibrant culture. What type of power outlet does Samoa use?

Samoa uses power outlets and plugs of type I. Take a look at the picture below to see what this plug and power socket looks like: Doesn't look familiar?

Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type I - Used in Australia, New Zealand, the South Pacific, China and Argentina.

Can I use power plugs in Samoa?

Select your country of residence, to check the compatibility of your power plugs in Samoa. In Samoa, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type I are used. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. For more information, select the country you live in at the top of this page. We don't sell power plug adapters.

Do I need a power adapter in Samoa?

The standard voltage in Samoa is 230V, and the frequency is 50Hz. Devices from countries with different voltage standards, like the United States (120V), may require a voltage converter in addition to a plug adapter. Do You Need a Power Adapter in Samoa?

Whether you'll need a power adapter depends on the type of plug your devices use.

What type of power socket is used in Samoa?



The power sockets in Samoa are of type I. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter in Samoa.

Can a universal power adapter fit a Samoa outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Samoa outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

Can you use a charger in Samoa?

Chargers for iPhones, Android phones and other smartphones or cell phones are usually dual voltage, so you can use them all over the world. However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Samoa outlet. Samoa uses electrical outlets and power plugs of type I (see images).

Sockets in Samoa: Adapters required for travelers from USA?

In Samoa, type I power outlets are used, while in USA, you use plugs A and B. If you're traveling to Samoa, you'll need a power adapter for types I, as your power plugs won't fit the sockets there.

Since Samoa uses Type I outlets, you'll need a Type A/B to Type I adapter. Additionally, as the voltage in North America is different, you may also need a voltage converter for devices that ...
