What is the telecommunications system in Suriname?

Telecommunications in Suriname includes radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. Broadcast stations: 1 state-owned radio station; multiple private radio stations (2007). Broadcast stations: 2 state-owned TV stations; multiple private TV stations (2007). Main lines: 5 lines, 209th in the world (2015).

What is Telesur Suriname?

Suriname's fixed telecom services are controlled by the monopoly provider Telesur, though there is effective competition in the mobile market, which is served by is Telesur and Digicel.

Is TeleSUR a good telco in Suriname?

The state-owned incumbent telco, Telesur, is the only provider of fixed-line and fixed broadband services in Suriname. The country's fixed-line infrastructure is reasonably reliable in the more populated coastal region, though poor in the interior.

Why is Telesur launching a 5G network in Paramaribo?

Telesur launches its 5G network in Paramaribo, markets triple-play offering and high-volume mobile data packages; Suriname ranked 81st internationally for mobile network speeds and 158th for fixed broadband speeds; Significant recent gold and offshore oil discoveries to boost economic growth;
